### **Rayma presents her first sculpture in the new exhibition “The Heartbeat in Evolution”**

The famous Venezuelan artist Rayma Suprani will present a new exhibition in the city of Miami, on November 4th and 5th, at the renowned **Alex Slato Gallery**.

This exhibition consists of approximately 16 pieces in different materials and techniques, which revolve around the artist's exhaustive research to achieve the evolution of her original piece “**Corazón Venezuela**”. This illustration has a special meaning since it was inspired as a reflection of the historical events that occurred in 2014.

The evolutionary work of the work shows the flexibility and plasticity of the forms that make up the connection between various hearts represented in metal prints, acrylic paintings on canvas, drawings in graphite and metallic watercolor, as well as animations in digital format.

In this exhibition, Rayma's first sculpture is unveiled: “**Mirror Heart**” or “**Corazón Espejo**”, a piece that invites you to experience the close connection of the heartbeat in the reflection of its forms, a first step towards the three-dimensionality of space and use of new materials.

The exhibition, with free admission, will be open to the public for only 2 days, with the presence of the artist at the Alex Slato Gallery, located at 710 NW 55st. Miami, FL 33127, on Saturday, November 4th from 2pm to 8pm and Sunday, November 5th from 2pm to 4pm.
